#### Can you believe it's April already! Where has the Winter Season Gone?



#### Monthly Courtesy Patrol News

With the onset of Spring and Summer Voyager says bon voyage to some of the residents as they set off to their next destination.

There are many things to think about at this time, and preparing your Voyager home for your return is probably at the top of the list. Here are a few tips for you to consider:

- **Keep It Cool:** With temperatures soaring, keeping your home's interior cool and comfortable is crucial. Close blinds or curtains and consider installing sheltering or shade sails to reduce heat gain.
- **Pest Control:** Summer is prime time for pesky critters like ants, mosquitoes, and flies. Keep them away by sealing cracks and crevices, storing food properly, and maintaining a tidy outdoor space. Consider using natural repellents.
- Outdoor Care: Ensure that the outside of your Park Model is taken care of while you are away and have weeds pulled and plants maintained. The rains of summer bring the weeds!!
- Exterior Inspection: Inspect your park model's exterior for any signs of damage or wear and tear, such as loose siding, cracked windows, or damaged roofing. Remember, the Summer months bring monsoon rain and high winds.
- Clean Gutters and Downspouts: Winter debris and leaves can clog your gutters, leading to water damage and potential leaks. Grab a ladder and clear out any debris, ensuring proper drainage away from your home's foundation.
- **Deck Maintenance:** If your park model home has a deck, now's the time to give it some TLC. Sweep away debris, inspect for any loose boards or nails, and apply a fresh coat of sealant to protect against moisture and UV damage.
- **Drain all water:** Open all faucets and the shower, letting the water drain completely.
- Drain the water heater: Open the water heater drain valve and allow all water to drain.
- Disconnect the power: Turn off the main breaker panel and disconnect any external power cords.
- Unplug appliances: Unplug all electrical appliances.




