




Last month we started a series of sermons from the New Testament Book of James. We'll be continuing that series in February.





February is one of our busiest months, with our community welcoming a higher number of residents and visitors. With more activity throughout the area, it's a great time for a gentle safety check-in and a reminder of everyday habits that help keep our community running smoothly.

As part of that, we encourage everyone to practice simple, routine home safety habits. Locking doors and windows, using exterior lighting, and keeping vehicles secured are easy steps that help prevent accidental issues and give you peace of mind, especially when you're out enjoying community events or spending time with friends.

With increased activity, there is also more movement on our roads and paths. Vehicles, golf carts, bicycles, and pedestrians are sharing the same spaces, so staying alert is key. Drivers are asked to slow down and watch carefully, while walkers, cyclists, and golf cart users should remain aware of their surroundings and follow posted guidelines.

Shorter daylight hours mean many activities happen in lower light. For visibility and safety, please use lights on bicycles and golf carts, wear reflective clothing when possible, and carry a flashlight when walking after dusk. Being visible helps everyone see and avoid one another. Wear reflective or light-colored clothing and consider using LED armbands, light-up vests, or clip-on lights so drivers and cyclists can see you easily. For your dog, a glowing or reflective collar, leash, or harness helps keep them visible at all times. Carrying a small flashlight or headlamp not only helps you see where you're going, but also alerts others to your presence.
