










The hot weather is here. This will bring out Rattlesnakes. Tarantulas, Javelins, and other pests. Keep your leashed pets at the prescribed distance of 6 feet or less from you to assist in keeping you and them safe.

Pet owners cannot utilize vacant lots for their pet to relieve itself. Not cleaning up after your pet is not only a violation of Voyager Rules but of Pima County Code 6.04.030 (E). Unattended pets are not permitted at any time, including in yards and rental sites

For the safety of yourself and your pet, pet owners or their guests may not have pets in tow while riding a bicycle or driving any motorized vehicle.

If you are leaving your pets at home, consider having them situated so as not to bark at passing residents, pets and vehicles.

Pet owners are not allowed to let their pets enter any residents yard area or carport at any time. Residents are well within their rights to ask you to remove your pet from their property.

In general, pets and their owners need to keep on paved streets.

Mail Room Parking. Please note that the handicapped parking spots in front of the mail room are for golf carts only. Trucks, cars, jeeps, vans etcetera need to utilize the full-size parking spots off 4th Street. There have been too many near misses involving pedestrians and at least one employee had his vehicle damaged. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated
