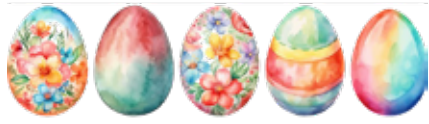

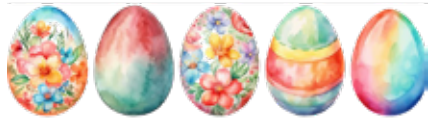
## ALISA DUPUY AS BETSY ROSS

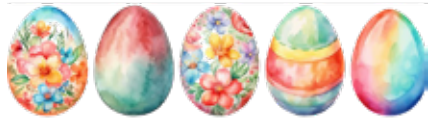

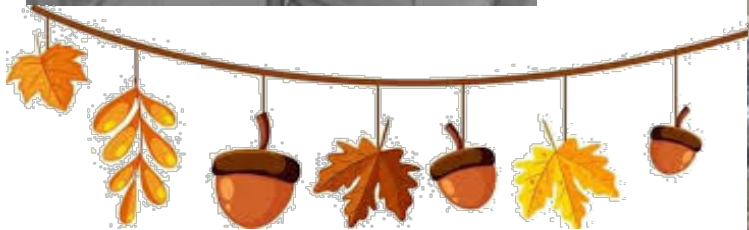

As we welcome another wonderful month in our community, we would like to share a few important reminders to help keep Voyager safe, respectful, and enjoyable for everyone.

**Contractor Refuse:** Any debris or refuse created by contractors must be removed from the property for proper disposal. Thank you for ensuring job sites are left clean and tidy.

**Wildlife:** Please do not feed wildlife. Feeding animals can create safety concerns and disrupt the natural balance of our desert environment.

**Attention Walkers:** For your safety, please walk facing traffic and consider wearing a reflective vest and/or carrying a bright flashlight, especially during early morning or evening hours.

**Misdelivered Packages:** If you receive a package addressed to someone else within Voyager, Cove or the Bay, please contact Courtesy Patrol at 520-574-5400. An officer will gladly retrieve the parcel and ensure that it reaches the correct homeowner.

**Road Safety:** There is no passing on entry or exit roads to and from Kolb Road.

**Vacant & Occupied Spaces:** Walking, biking, or driving through any vacant or occupied home site is prohibited. Entering any home site without permission constitutes trespassing.

**Speed Limit:** Please remember the community speed limit is 15 mph. Slowing down helps protect pedestrians, pets, and fellow residents.

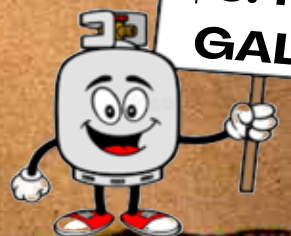

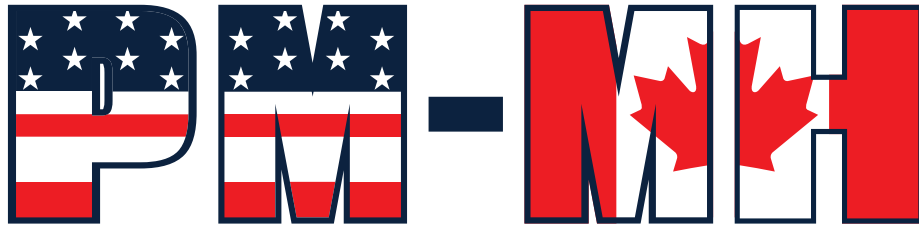
