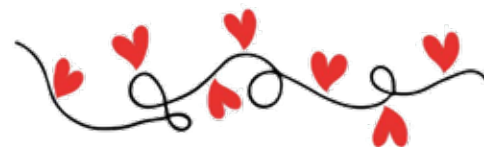

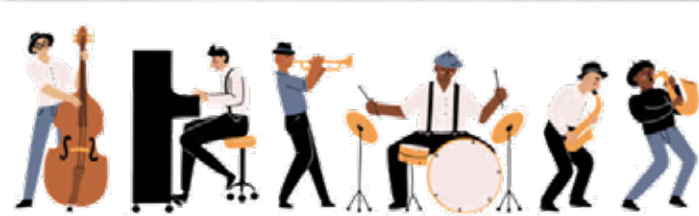

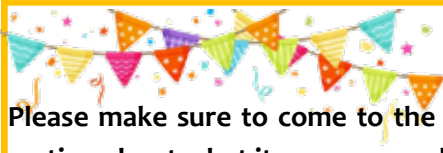
### **Golf Board Report**
