MAIL ROOM PARKING: The handicapped parking spots in front of the mail room are for golf carts only. Trucks, cars, jeeps, vans etcetera need to utilize the full-size parking spots off 4th Street. There have been too many near misses involving pedestrians and at least one employee had his vehicle damaged. Your cooperation is appreciated.

BADGES: Name badges are always required while using Resort facilities and must be worn by all residents, sublessees, guests, and visitors to all activities and during use of all amenities. Badges are issued by the Registration Office during office hours. For security reasons, anyone in the Resort without a badge at any time will be asked to display their badge and/ or provide identification. Anyone without a badge or a valid form of identification will be required to leave the Resort and/or Resort Facilities. Voyager charges a fee to replace any lost, stolen, or damaged badges. Just because an individual has acquired a badge does not mean that the person has been approved for residency in the Resort.

COMMUNITY AWARENESS: The season is over. Most of the people remining here are residents. We can no longer use the seasonal guests to blame for the dangerous driving conditions we have here at the Voyager. We need to look to each other to keep taking the steps necessary for a safe driving environment. The near misses are mounting up. I would hate to have someone injured or killed to bring this to the forefront. The seconds we think we save are not worth the risk.

POOL PATROLS: We will be performing random walks through the pool areas. If you do not have your badge accessible to identify yourself, you will be required to go to your home, casita or hotel room and get it. This is the only means to identify individuals who come to the resort on false pretenses and come to the pools.
