**PARK MODEL PAINTING:** All paintings of park models or mobile or manufactured homes must have written pre-approval of Voyager Management for color, type, etc. Requests should be submitted on a Painting Application, available at the Registration Office. If pre-approval is not obtained by Voyager Management, residents may be required to repaint their home at their own expense.

**MAIL ROOM PARKING:** The handicapped parking spots in front of the mail room are for golf carts only. Trucks, cars, jeeps, vans etcetera need to utilize the full-size parking spots off 4th Street. There have been too many near misses involving pedestrians and at least one employee had his vehicle damaged. Your cooperation is appreciated.

**BADGES:** Name badges are always required while using Resort facilities and must be worn by all residents, sublessees, guests, and visitors to all activities and during use of all amenities. Badges are issued by the Registration Office during office hours. For security reasons, anyone in the Resort without a badge at any time will be asked to display their badge and/or provide identification. Anyone without a badge or a valid form of identification will be required to leave the Resort and/or Resort Facilities. Voyager charges a fee to replace any lost, stolen, or damaged badges. Just because an individual has acquired a badge does not mean that the person has been approved for residency in the Resort.

**ANNUAL AND SUBLESSE BADGES:** Voyager provides name badges for all annual residents and sublessees. A new badge shall be obtained each season.

**TRAFFIC AND STOP SIGNS:** The speed limit is 15 MPH throughout Voyager. The speed limit will be enforced by Voyager for your safety. All vehicles (cars, bicycles, golf carts, etc.) must obey all traffic signs and speed limits.

Everyone needs to stop at all stop signs. If the stop sign is recessed back from the intersection, stop at the sign, and slowly move forward to ensure the intersection is clear before proceeding. If the stop sign is at an unobstructed view intersection you still must stop, look in all directions and proceed when safe to do so.
