This is a Bring Your Own Service event. We will provide water, coffee and lemonade.



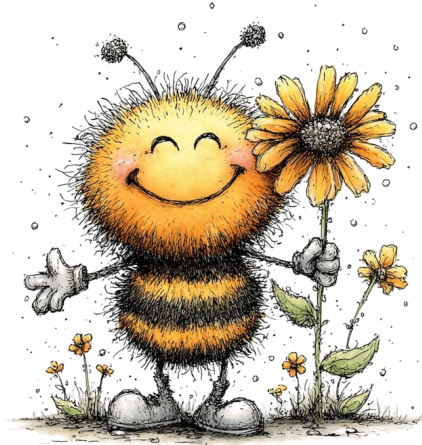
Angel Face Ice Cream Van

Let's start off Spring with these reminders:

Contractor Refuse: Any refuse created by a contractor must be taken off property for disposal.

Walking & Wildlife: Please do not feed wildlife. A reminder to all walkers, please walk facing traffic and wear a vest and/or carry a bright flashlight. A reminder that walking, biking or driving through any vacant or occupied space is prohibited. Also, entering home sites for which you do not have permission, whether vacant or occupied, is not permitted and constitutes trespassing. There is no passing on the entry or exit roads to and from Kolb Road.

Package Delivery: As a courtesy to others, if you receive a package at home addressed to someone else in the Voyager, Crossing or Bay, please contact Courtesy Patrol at 520-574-5400 and request an officer to come get the parcel and take it to the right homeowner.

Overnight RV Parking: Please contact Courtesy Patrol at 520-574-5006 to request a parking pass if you will be parking your RV/trailer/van overnight. Please do this before parking your unit. A pass will be delivered to you at your home.
